NOTICE OF MEETINGS

The Board of Education believes that public notice of its activities is essential to ongoing, proactive cooperation between the Board and the community it serves.

To this end, and in accordance with state law, notice of meetings shall be sent to all members of the Board, Superintendent of Schools, District Treasurer, and to the newspapers of the district. The time and date of regular Board meetings is established at the annual re-organizational meeting. If a meeting is scheduled at least a week in advance, notice must be given to the public by giving notice to the media and posting in one or more designated public places not less than 72 hours prior to the meeting.

When a meeting is scheduled less than a week in advance the Board shall provide public notice to the extent practicable. Said notice shall be conspicuously posted in one or more designated public locations and by giving notice to the media.

Unless otherwise designated in the notice, all meetings shall be held in the Catskill Senior High School Library and all meetings of the Board shall be open to the public unless the Board adjourns into executive session in accordance with Section 1708 of the Education Law and/or the Open Meetings Law.
