SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

The Board of Education shall by a majority vote appoint a Superintendent of Schools for a term of no less than three years and not to exceed five years. The Superintendent shall serve as the chief executive officer of the Board and as such shall carry out the policies established by the Board.

The Board shall notify appropriate college placement offices of any vacancy for the position of Superintendent. The Board shall also authorize the placement of advertisements in local, regional and national publications.

The Board shall also prepare a brochure to be distributed to candidates and appropriate agencies which lists the qualifications for the position of Superintendent and describes the school district.
