ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCILS, CABINETS, COMMITTEES

The Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent of Schools to establish such permanent or temporary councils and committees as he/she deems necessary for proper administration of Board policies and for the improvement of the total educational program.

All councils and committees created by the Superintendent will be for the purpose of obtaining the advice and counsel of administrative, teaching, and non-instructional personnel of the district and to aid in district communication. Functioning in an advisory capacity, these groups may make recommendations to the Superintendent for consideration by the Board. However, such groups will exercise no inherent authority. Authority for establishing policy remains with the Board and authority for implementing policy remains with the Superintendent.
