

## STUDENT TRANSPORTATION FOR SCHOOL SPONSORED TRAVEL REGULATION

The new legislation regarding conveyance of students to and from athletic events, field trips and other student activities does not always require a student who rides the school bus to the activity to ride it back to the district location of origin or other school building site, etc. If a parent presents a signed letter prior to an activity indicating that the parent (not someone else's parent or a student) will be meeting his/her child at the site of said activity to drive the child away, the same could be done without a violation of law having occurred.

To that end, the following prototype letter will be used:

Dear \_\_\_\_\_ : I am the parent of \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_, a student who participates in the \_\_\_\_\_\_ activity. It is my understanding that my child will be the transported by a school district vehicle site of the following activity: to the following date(s): on . I am hereby requesting that I be allowed to pick-up my child from the activity, whereupon he/she will not be transported back to the district as otherwise required by the Education Law.
