INDIVIDUAL HELP/TUTORING

The Board of Education believes that by maintaining a high-quality instructional staff and providing for a rich, varied curriculum, the need for individual tutoring will be minimized.

It is expected that every effort will be made by teachers and Building Principals to help a student with his/her difficulties in school before recommending that parents engage a tutor.

However, should individual tutoring be recommended in certain cases, such tutoring for which the instructor receives a fee will not be done in district school buildings.

Before undertaking to provide individual tutoring for pay to any district student, a professional staff member will first give written notice of such fact to the Superintendent of Schools.
