STUDENT AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

The Board of Education mandates that all students regardless of race, color, creed, sex, national origin, religion, marital status, sexual orientation, or disability shall be eligible for all awards and scholarships administered and awarded by the school district.

Selection criteria for scholarships administered and awarded by the district will be available for review in the Main Office or Guidance Office.

The Guidance Office will assist students applying for student awards and scholarships not administered by the district at the student's request by providing transcripts and other required information. Such requests must be made in a timely manner. Parents of students under the age of 18 must sign a student information release form to authorize the district to provide such information to one or more scholarship organizations. Students who are 18 years of age or older may sign the release authorization.
