WHEREAS, New York Real Property Tax Law (RPTL) §487 (2) states in pertinent part that real property improved by the installation of a solar or wind energy system or farm waste energy system shall be exempt from taxation of any increase in value by reason of the inclusion of such solar or wind energy system; and WHEREAS, RPTL §487 (9) further states, in pertinent part, that a county, city, town, village or school district may require the owner of the real property which includes a solar or wind energy system or farm waste energy system to enter into a contract for payments in lieu of taxes (PILOT); and

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WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Schools notified Bogart Solar LLC of the District's intent, to negotiate PILOT programs with solar and wind energy system providers.

WHEREAS, Cypress Creek Renewables (d.b.a. Bogart Solar, LLC) notified Catskill Central School District on September 6, 2017 of their intent to construct a solar energy system located at 1180 Bogart Road, Catskill, NY; and

WHEREAS, The Superintendent of Schools notified Cypress Creek Renewables (d.b.a. Bogart Solar, LLC) in writing that it would require a PILOT for the project; and

WHEREAS, Catskill Central School District in coordination with the Town of Catskill and the County of Greene have negotiated a PILOT with Bogart Solar, LLC;

NOW, THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of Education hereby accepts the terms of the PILOT; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Board President is hereby authorized to enter into the payment in lieu of taxes (PILOT), subject to approval as to form by the District legal counsel and subject to the adoption of a similar Resolution by the Town of Catskill and the County of Greene, with Bogart Solar, LLC.

Further, if the classroom teacher receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period he/she shall not be eligible for tenure at that time, in which case the Board of Education, in its discretion, may extend the teacher's probationary term for an additional year), at an annual salary of MA +30 Step 13 of the CTA Salary Schedule (\$70,336). This position will be paid for from the General Fund.
