Dear Catskill Central School Families,

I am delighted to inform you that the Catskill Central School District will be continuing the Community Eligibility Provision meal certification program for the 2019-2020 school year.

What does this mean for your child(ren) that are enrolled in Catskill Central School District?

- * **ALL students**, PreK – 12, enrolled in the Catskill Central School District are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at **no charge** to your household each school day of the 2019-2020 school year.
- * No further action is required of you.
- * Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit an application.

What is the Community Eligibility Provision?

The Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) is a federal program that provides **free breakfast and lunch to all students** at qualifying school districts, regardless of income. CEP also replaces the Free and Reduced Lunch Program at Catskill Central School District for the 2019-2020 school year.

Is there an application?

No application is required.

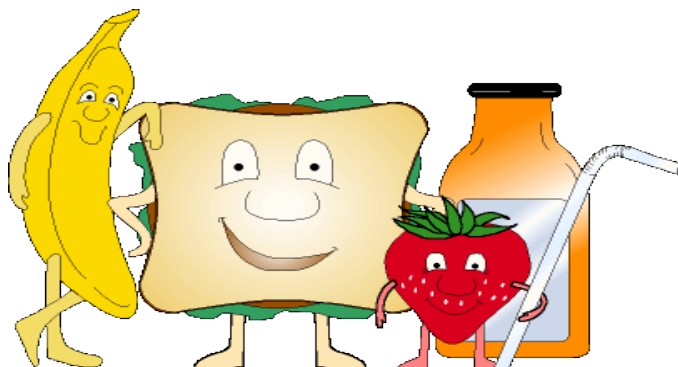


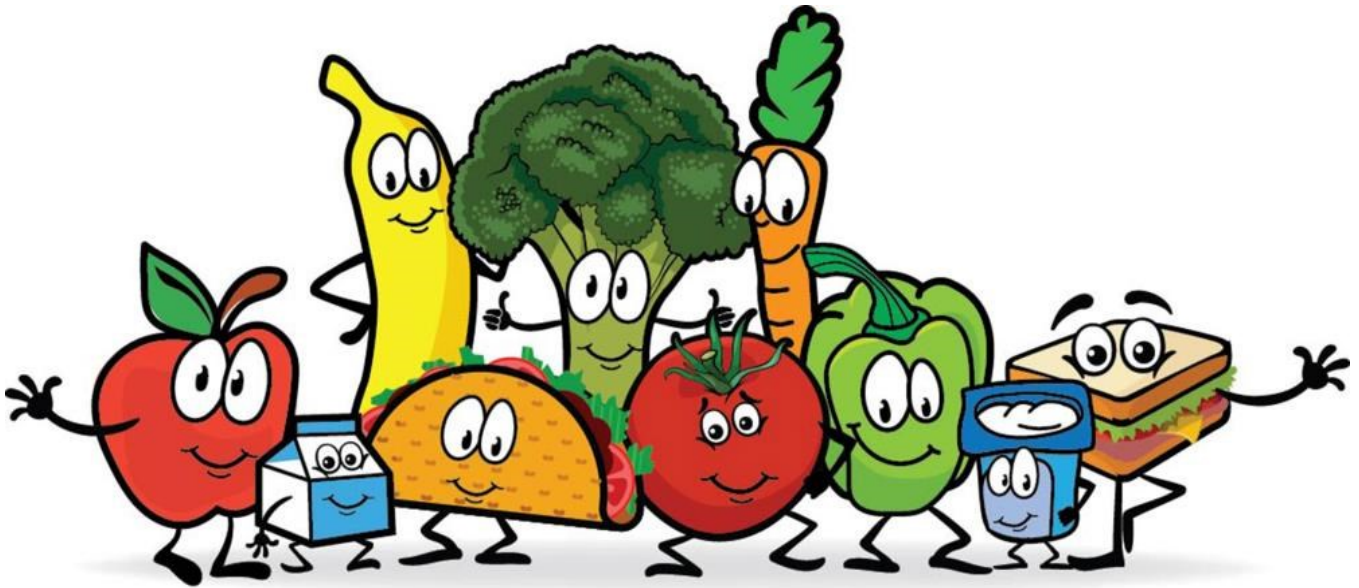
Will my child(ren) still need a MySchoolBucks account?

Individual student accounts may be maintained through MySchoolBucks. This allows families to prepay for additional breakfast/lunch purchases such as à la carte items, snack milk, ice cream, extra snacks, a second lunch, etc. (i.e. items beyond a standard breakfast/lunch).
