## **Local Agencies & Supports**

During this time, it can be very difficult to sift through and find local agencies and support needed in your community. Below is a list of resources and outreach groups that you may find helpful in the Catskill NY community. We have provided additional supports in the surrounding area of Ulster County to expand your resource options.

#### Essential Workers Childcare

- 1. The Office of Children and Family Services and the Cuomo Administration have developed a plan to provide child care to essential workers at no cost to the worker. This allocation of funding comes to the state from the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (the "CARES Act"), which has provided our state with \$163.6 million in emergency relief to the child care system.
- 2. Child Care Resource and Referral Agencies (CCRRs) provide services to parents and daycare providers in every county of New York State. If you are looking for child care, the CCRR in your county is a great place to start. They will ask you about the kind of care you are looking for, the ages of your children, the hours of care you need and other specifics such as any special needs your child might have. Based on that information, they will be able to give you a list of providers that most closely meet your needs.

#### Food Assistance (Catskill Central School District):

#### **CCSD Dinner Program**

Catskill Central School District's Dinner Program provides free balanced meals for all Catskill students K-12. Starting February 3, 2020 our elementary, middle and high school students can stop by the Catskill Middle School Cafeteria from 2:15-4:00 p.m. on any regularly scheduled FULL school day and enjoy a healthy, delicious and balanced dinner! No registration is required.

### No-Charge Meals for All CCSD Students

Catskill CSD now participates in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP), a federal program that provides free meals to all students at qualifying school districts, regardless of income. Under this program, ALL students, PreK–12, enrolled in the Catskill Central School District are eligible to receive school meals at no charge to their families each school day of the 2019-2020 school year. CEP replaces the Free and Reduced Lunch Program at Catskill CSD for the 2019-2020 school year. Families do not need to apply to take advantage of the CEP program
