

# What supplies does my Kindergartener need?



- 4 Boxes of Crayons
- ✓ Small, plastic, rectangular pencil box
- ✓ 10 glue sticks
- Expo markers
- ✓ 3-Two-pocket folders (plastic works best)
- ✓ 2-Composition notebooks
- ✓ Baby wipes
- Child-size scissors
- ✔ Brown paper lunch bags
- ✓ Face masks

### WHAT ELSE SHOULD I SEND TO SCHOOL EACH DAY?



- A backpack that your child can open and close without help.
- A two-pocket folder especially for communication. Please check this every day. We will use it to send important information home to you. You can use it to send absence notes, transportation plans, homework questions or other concerns to school.

## What should my child wear to school?

### Comfortable clothing and shoes.

Your child should be able to put on, zip or button their clothes without help. Shoes should cover your child's toes and fit well.

No overalls, party clothes, flip-flops, heels, open-toed sandals, or hats indoors, please!

You should send a labeled Ziplock bag with a full, backup outfit (including underwear and socks) to keep at school.

All clothing should be LABELED inside with your child's full name.



## How will I stay informed?

#### Weekly or Monthly Classroom Newsletters

- Will be placed in your child's folder to bring home.
- Contain important information, report card dates, upcoming field trips, and classroom news.
- ☐ Share lesson themes and learning objectives.
- Give suggestions for working with your child at home

- Share grade-level and school-wide events, holidays, scheduling, and other information.

# Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up

#### OUR BRAND NEW DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP LOOP BEGINS ON SCENIC DRIVE



- Students may be dropped off beginning at 8:35 AM via the new car loop and enter through the Red Wing doors. (See map.)
- All pick-ups after 3:00 PM must use the car loop. Please do not exit your vehicle. A staff member will bring you a sign-out sheet. Your child will be brought to your car.
- A <u>VALID ID</u> is required to pick up your child from school, <u>even if</u> you have picked them up before.
- You must call the Main Office before 11:00 AM to pick your child up without a note.
- Late arrivals (after 9:00 AM) and early dismissals (before 3:00 PM) should use the front entrance.

## What about breakfast and lunch?

- ☐ Thanks to a federal grant, CES will provide <u>FREE breakfast and lunch to every student</u> during the 2021-22 school year. There are no forms to fill out or programs to apply for.
- ☐ You may still add funds to your child's MySchoolBucks account if you'd like them to have extra money to spend on snacks or ice cream.
