

What supplies does my Pre-K student need?



- Masks/cloth face coverings to be worn at school
- ✓ 2 boxes of 24 crayons
- ✓ 1 plastic pencil case
- ✓ 4 glue sticks
- ✔ A pair of child-safe scissors
- Art smock (an old shirt) for projects and painting
- ✓ <u>A water bottle with a secure lid</u>
- ✓ A yoga mat that can be rolled up for storage (for rest time)
- ✓ A blanket or towel (for rest time; this will go home weekly)
- ✓ A picture of your family to keep at school for those tough days

Please label all items with your child's full name!



- A backpack that your child can open and close without help.
- A two-pocket folder especially for communication. Please check this every day. We will use it to send important information home to you. You can use it to send absence notes, transportation plans, homework questions or other concerns to school.

What should my child wear to school?

Comfortable clothing and shoes.

- Your child should be able to put on, zip or button their clothes without help. Shoes should cover your child's toes and fit well.
- No overalls, party clothes, flip-flops, heels, open-toed sandals, or hats indoors, please!
- You should send a labeled Ziplock bag with a full, backup outfit (including underwear and socks) to keep at school.

All clothing should be <u>LABELED</u> inside with your child's full name.



What about breakfast and lunch?

- → Thanks to a federal grant, CES will provide FREE breakfast and lunch to every student during the 2021-22 school year. There are no forms to fill out or programs to apply for.
- → You may still add funds to your child's MySchoolBucks account if you'd like them to have money for snacks or ice cream, or if you choose to send a packed lunch and have your child buy milk at school.
- Please notify us immediately of any allergies or religious/cultural food restrictions your child has.

How will I stay informed?

Remind

- → Is an app that allows you to text directly with your child's teacher
- → Install it on your phone and your Pre-K teacher will give you a code to connect with her

Weekly or Monthly Classroom Newsletters

- → Will be placed in your child's folder to bring home.
- → Contain important information, upcoming events & classroom news.
- → Share lesson themes and learning objectives.
- → Give suggestions for working with your child at home.

CES Week at a Glance and Monthly Calendar

- → Will be emailed/texted to you & posted on the website.
- → Share grade-level and school-wide events, holidays, scheduling, and other information.





How should I keep <u>you</u> informed?

→ If you need to alter your child's dismissal plan, please send written permission to school. You may also call the Main Office <u>before 11 am</u>.





→ We take your child's safety seriously, and <u>must be</u> <u>able to reach you in case of emergency</u>.

Any time you move, change your phone number, or need to alter your child's emergency contacts, please <u>notify us as soon as possible</u>.

9:15 AM: Pre-K Drop-Off



Drop-off for Pre-K will be located at the Pre-K playground door. Please pull along the sidewalk and stay in your vehicle. A staff member will come to bring your child inside.

Earlier than 9:15 AM: DO NOT drop off your Pre-K child.

Later than 9:15 AM: To sign your child in late, please go to the main doors of the school.

<u>9:30 AM</u>: Breakfast in classroom (CES provides free breakfast and lunch.)

<u>11:15 AM</u>: Lunch in the cafeteria (CES provides free breakfast and lunch.)

<u>2:00 PM</u>: Snack in classroom (**Please send your child with a snack!**)

2:45 PM: Pre-K Pick-Up (PLEASE BE PROMPT)


Pick-up for Pre-K will be via the front doors of the elementary school. Please park in the bus circle at the front of the building and wait for a staff member with a sign-out sheet. Students will be brought out to their families.

Important: (ID is required for pick-up, even if you have picked up your child before.)

First Days of School

Monday, September 13th will be a "slow start" <u>half day</u>. Pre-K will dismiss at 11:00 AM.

Please park in the bus circle and wait. You will need to sign your child out.



The first <u>FULL DAY of Pre-K</u> (9:15 AM to 2:45 PM) will be Tuesday, September 14th.
