Technology Upgrades in 2022-23

- 44 network switches replaced all district switches. The project to install them took place this past summer.
- 247 wireless access points replaced all district WAPs. The project to install them took place this past summer.
- 250 teacher and staff laptops were purchased.
- All 140 of our classroom printers were updated to replace printers. Some printers were up to 18 years old.
- Purchased 180 iPads replacing some of the older iPads in all schools.
- Chromeboxes were purchased to connect to all 130 Promethean boards to make the boards faster and more user friendly.
- The Digital Studio in the HS had all the equipment updated in the Control Room and Production Room for the first time since it was opened 14 years ago.
- The addition of an Instructional Technology Coordinator position. This position bridges the gap between technology and the teacher's curriculum.



2023-2024 Technology Needs

- Computer upgrades to both the HS and MS Tech labs. The cost for 43 computers is \$93,780.00.
- Need to update all desktop computers District wide, including all the office spaces. The cost to replace them would be \$169,438.00.
- Now that the Control Room and Production Room in the HS Digital Studio has been updated, we need to update the Mac computers in the Post Production Room. The cost to replace the Mac computers is \$84,000.00.
