

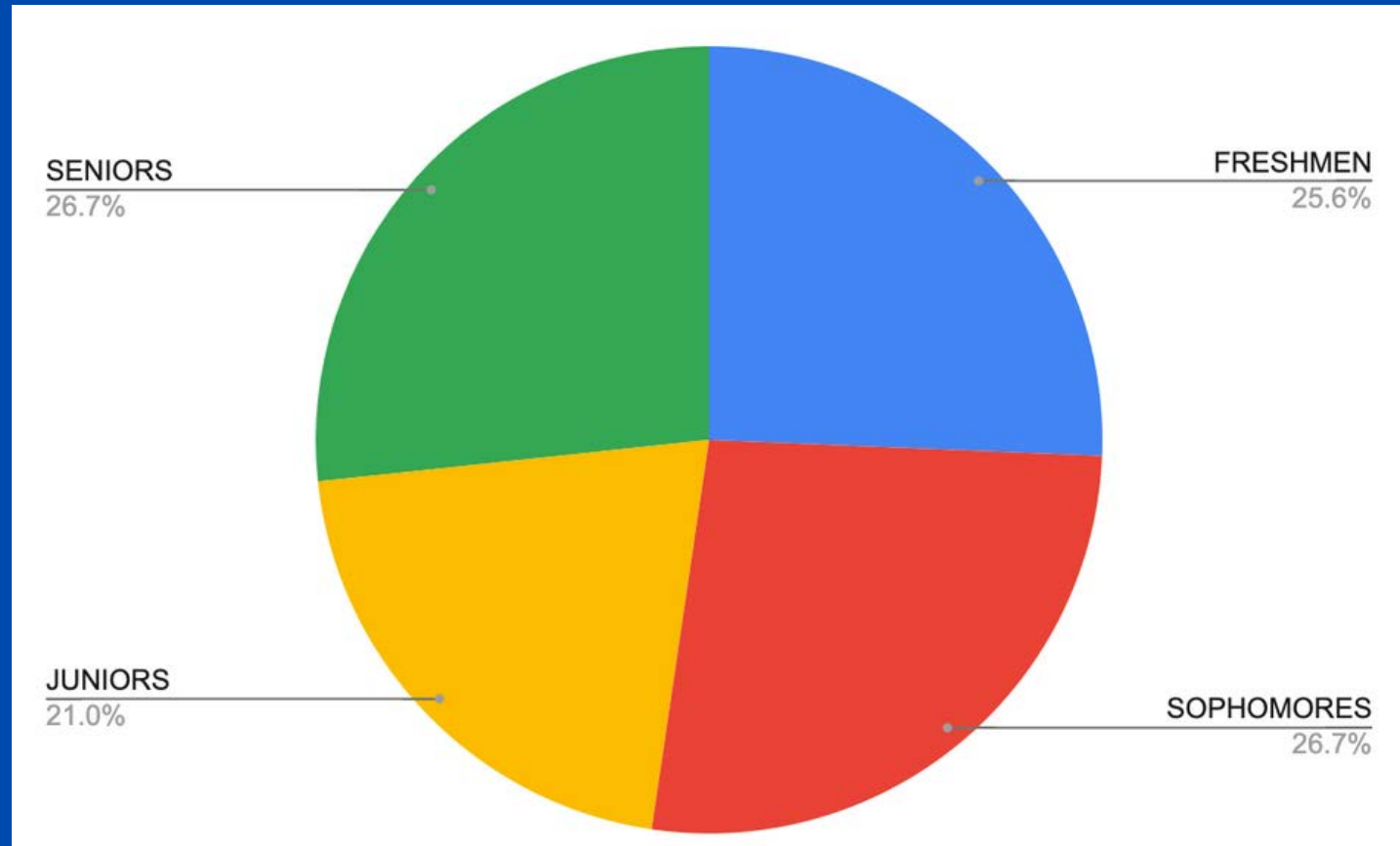

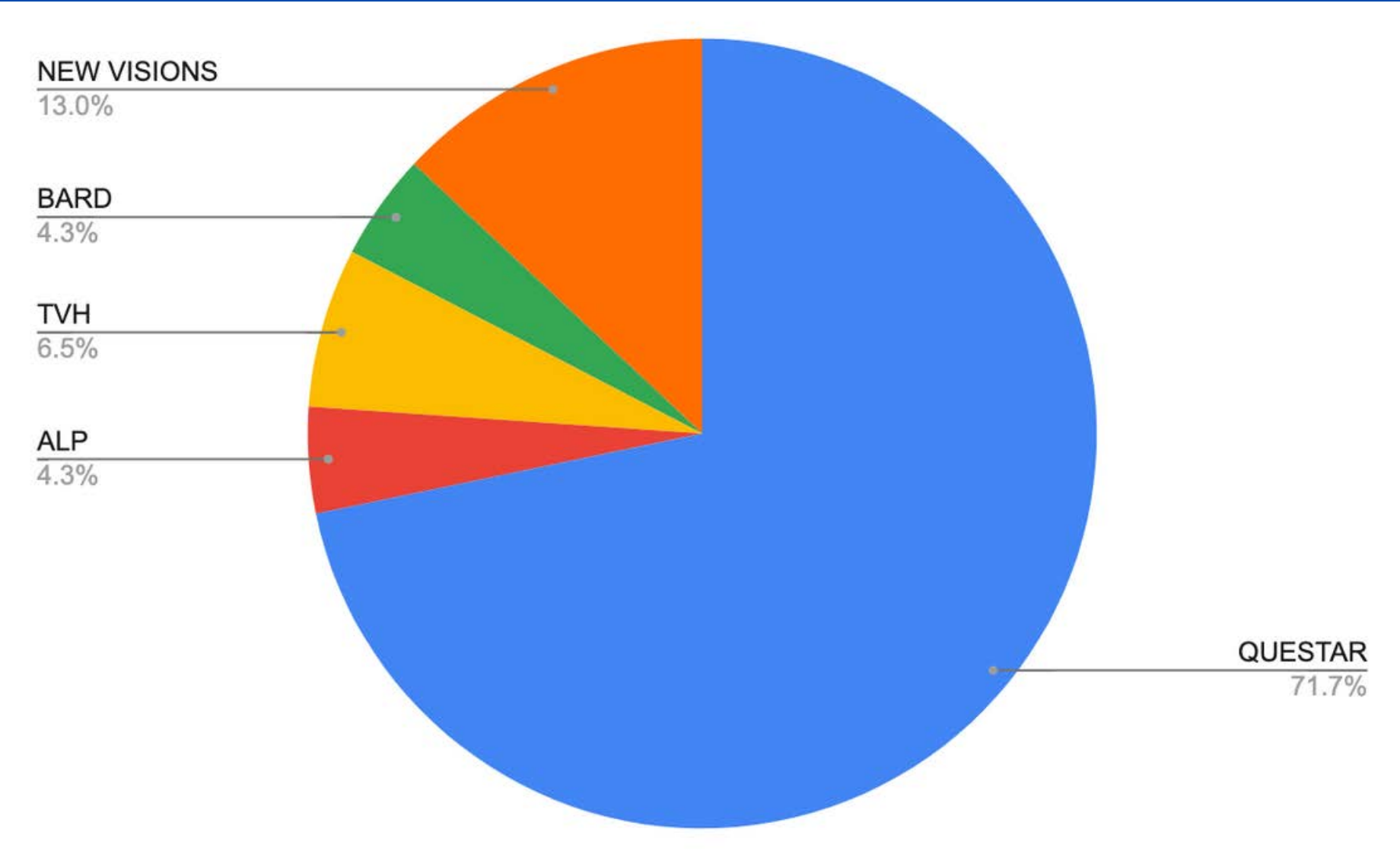

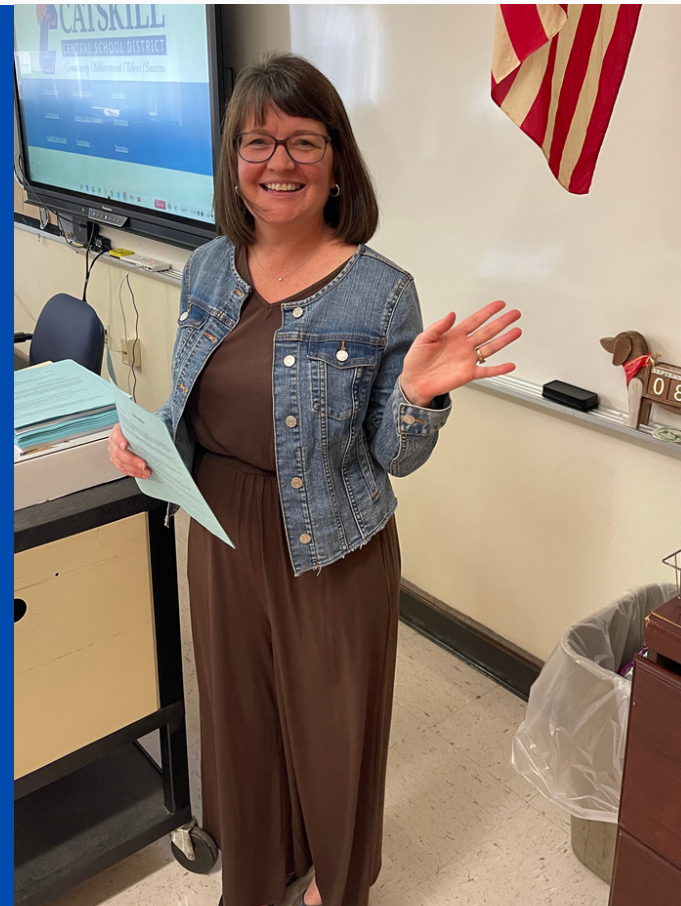

Pre-Calculus will be transitioning to an AP course as well as the addition of AP Spanish for the next school year



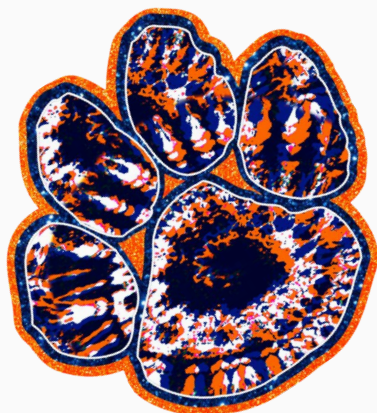
Carnegie Hall
