## ELIGIBILITY FOR EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES REGULATION

## Eligibility Standards

1. Academic Eligibility Determination
a. A student must maintain an overall average of 70 in 3 core classes and physical education each marking period.
b. Determination for fall participation rests upon the previous year's performance.
c. A student who does not meet eligibility requirements has until the next five-week interim report period conclusion to meet the requirements and is placed on academic probation.
d. During the academic probation period, the student may fully participate on the team.
e. During the academic probation period, the student will attend and participate in a minimum of three after-school study sessions.
f. In addition, other school-assigned interventions may be required if deemed necessary for student success.
g. If the student does not participate in the after-school program and shows improvement at the fiveweek interim report time, he/she will become "Ineligible to Participate." (See 2.a).
2. Ineligible to Compete
a. If a student is not passing the subjects in question at the five-week interim report period, they will be ineligible to participate in any extra-curricular activity for the next five weeks.
b. It is expected that the student will attend the after-school study session outlined in 1 b .
c. If the student's situation improves within the five-week period, the student may request reconsideration of ineligibility status.
d. To request reconsideration, a student must complete a status form, signed by each teacher, and present it to the principal.
e. The Principal will then clear the student for practice and play, and notify the coach and athletic director.

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
