HONOR ROLLS

The development of student intellectual ability, desirable traits of character and qualities of leadership are all achievements the school system desires to encourage and foster. In recognition of outstanding student achievement, the Board of Education supports academic recognition programs. These programs may include honor rolls, honor societies, and special awards.

The Board shall encourage the certified staff to develop criteria and procedures for these recognition programs. In all cases, the relationship between the honor and the relevant goal of the school shall be made explicitly clear.

The honor roll is a quarterly recognition for student academic achievement. Outstanding achievement leads to many options as students look to the future. The following criteria will serve as "Honor Roll" specifications for grades \underline{six} (6) through twelve (12).

MERIT

- Numerical Average of 80-84
- No numerical grade below passing
- Successful completion of Physical Education requirement

HONOR

- Numerical Average of **85-90**
- No numerical grade below passing
- Successful completion of Physical Education requirement

HIGH HONOR

- Numerical Average of **90-100**
- No numerical grade below passing
- Successful completion of Physical Education requirement
